Don't Look Now is an eerily effective mixture of the supernatural and the thriller, all splendidly served up by Nicolas Roeg. While in the autumnally beautiful and empty Venice, they meet a woman who claims she can "see" their dead child. The husband is sceptical, but the wife is strangely comforted by this fantastic possibility. Between these differing reactions their marriage is suddenly put to the test.
