- 116] 'And Kay Hoog?'
- 117] 'Kay Hoog will not cross our path again...he now knows of the power of the Spiders.'

- 118] Kay Hoog.
- 'I can assure you that I have finally succeeded in organizing a raid of the building in question.'
- 120] 'But how are you involved in the whole matter?'
- 121] 'I have an old score to settle.'
- 122] 'The raid is planned for 11 o'clock sharp.'
- 123] 'I will join in.'
- 124] A modern raid.
- 125] '6.5 carat...70.000 dollars...once...twice...'
- 126] In the subterranean Chinese town.
- 127] 'The secret of the many diamond robberies.'
- 128] The following day.
- 129] An old bookworm (an old professor).
- 'This is proof of my suspicion that the police will not acknowledge at any cost. Beneath the Chinese quarter, an underground Chinese town exists, and this fragment of ivory permits your entrance.'
- 'Look for this sign in one of the Chinese shops...there you will find the way leading to the underground Chinese town.'

- 'I intend to stay for two more days until the initial excitement has died down. Tomorrow evening I will be on board the 'Sturmvogel', and we may sail at once.'

- 'Set this woman free, and you may leave without interference.'
- 'I promise you in the name of Buddha, the Almighty, that none of us will try to detain you.'

- 146] 'How much?'
- 147] Mr. Baker, an advocate who does not like to have anything to do with the law.
- 'I have heard from the port authority that 'Sturmvogel' is setting out for South America. Is that true?'
- 'It concerns the smuggling of a crate of secret documents from the United States, without giving the authorities a chance to look at the papers.'
- 'My client will pay 10.000 dollars if the contract is fulfilled, and 20.000 dollars when the crate is delivered with the seal intact.'
