Jacques Baratier has usually dealt with politico subjects or more heavyweight drama. Now he tries for one of the local softcore items. It still remains too stilted in simulation and thus a more likely item in spots where hardcore is still unshown. It does not have the character, weight or insights for more demanding firstruns Stateside but is a likely item for Latino spots.

It is the usual long hot summer with vacationers in a big plush house. A young boy awakening to love falls for a cousin, a rather demanding, teasing girl. He is first broken in by a compliant aunt and then finally gets his girl. There is his stuffy father who does not give in to a pursuing German au pair girl and the dotty but kindly grandmother and a hanger-on hippy.

It is all nicely shot, with some feel for character but not enough to give a more spirited porno possibility or for straighter usage on most marts. Thesps are good looking and perform amenably.
