An Academy Award nominee for Best Foreign Film, Three Brothers marks the emergence of Francesco Rosi as a mature and internationally important filmmaker. Even though Three Brothers touches on the problems of terrorism, troubled youth and socialist doctrines, the film is primarily a meditation on love and the human need to communicate. In the twenty-four hours the film covers, the brothers voice their beliefs in an effort to reach an understanding of each other and their own lives after the death of their mother. Three Brothers is a wonderous, emotional and sometimes tragic evocation of man's ability to complicate the simplicities of life. --DD
