The first feature from Kuleshov's experimental workshop was also the first radically original film of the Soviet era. A gleeful satire on the excesses of American antibolshevik propaganda, it is also an affectionate parody/analysis of American popular cinema with fights, chases and rescues brilliantly choreographed according to Kuleshov's "rehearsal method." Mr. West is separated from his bodyguard, Cowboy Jed, in Moscow by a gang of tricksters, intent on relieving him of as many dollars as possible by pandering to his innocent fears.
