In the 1915 serials *Les Vampires* by director Louis Feuillade, Irma Vep was the leader of a band of cat burglars that dressed in black suits, stole jewelry from the wealthy, and escaped over rooftops. Fast forward to 1996; action film star Maggie Cheung is cast as the infamous character by the director played by the legendary actor Jean-Pierre Léaud.
