



## DRIFTING CLOUDS

(Finland, 1996 96 min.)

There's something at once familiar and unconventional about Aki Kaurismaki's *Drifting Clouds*. For those who've savored the flying Finn's oeuvre (*Match Factory Girl*, *La Vie de Boheme*), his new outing

reiterates a deadpan fatalism that's oddly compelling yet essentially unthreatening. Ilona and Lauri believe there is order in life and that hard work pays off with dividends. Fate, however, deals a much stronger hand. Kaurismaki remains the most Dickensian of contemporary filmmakers in his facility to
