Physicist, Philosopher, Film Director might well sum up the career of Krzysztof Zanussi, the young genius from Poland. The Chicago Festival was the first to introduce him to the U.S. three years ago by featuring his "Behind the Wall." It now presents his fourth major work, very much a personal film. Zanussi uses consecutive scenes to mark the stages of life of a young scientist. These are interwoven with documentary material, and statements of scholars who comment. The film is a biographic essay full of ellipses, organized into a few main themes: the development of personality, the process of discovery, existential anxiety. Zanussi is regarded as the unique leader of the new wave of Polish Directors, asking questions that have not been touched upon previously by the Polish arts.
