**SEPARATION**—Sharmila Tagore, Indian actress, portrays the loving wife of an enlightened college student, played by Soumitra Chatterjee, in "Devi." Here she tells him how much she will miss him when he leaves their village for further study in Calcutta.



**CHALLENGE**—While her husband is away, the young wife is proclaimed a goddess by her father-in-law, a highly religious man who says he learned of her divinity in a dream. Here a peasant brings his sick son to be cured by the "goddess."
