Allah Tantou and Lumumba — Death of a Prophet. Two extraordinary, personal documentaries look back to the turbulence of the African independence movement of the 60's. Using home movies, old newsreels and narrative segments director David Achkar in Allah Tantou retraces his father's life, a Guinean diplomat who became a political prisoner. A daring work in which the filmmaker comes to terms with the father he never knew and his troubled feelings about his homeland. Guinea/France 1991. Biography and history are also linked in filmmaker Raoul Peck's Lumumba — Death of a Prophet. As colonialism in the Congo collapsed, Lumumba's charismatic presence was too hot not to be extinguished. Peck retraces with anger and nostalgia the rise and fall of this seminal figure. Germany/ Switzerland, 1991.
