A disappointment after the splendid work done by the same director. G. W. Pabst, in "Secrets of a Soul." Taken from a novel by Ilya Ehrenberg, said to be good, it never got to be a picture scenario. It is not anywhere near concentrated enough.

It begins interestingly enough in the Crimea, where a young French girl falls in love with a bolshevik agent. But when the two meet again in Paris the atmosphere is disturbed by the introduction of a burlesque

detective, the girl's uncle.

This character is murdered, and the youth is suspected of the crime. The girl discovers the real murder-

er, an international swindler.

Only good performances are by Uno Henning as the male lead and Brigitte Helm in a minor role. Edith Jehanne, French actress, did not pan out at all in the female lead.
