When Bubber Reeves (Robert Redford) escapes from the penitentiary after being convicted of a murder committed by someone else, Sheriff Calder (Marlon Brando) refuses to take orders from oil and cattle baron Val Rogers (E. G. Marshall) or anyone else in the execution of his duties. Val wants Bubber out of the way to cover up a love affair his son Jason (James Fox) is having with Bubber's wife, Anna (Jane Fonda). Calder's wife, Ruby (Angie Dickinson) tries to persuade her husband to stop trying to fight the whole town single-handedly. Sheriff Calder finally catches up with Bubber in a junk yard with the help of Anna and Jason, but not before Jason is killed by an explosion. The loss of his son ends Val Rogers' own dreams for the future. Finally, as Sheriff Calder is bringing Bubber back to justice, a drunken mob attacks and he dies on the jailhouse steps. Calder decides to leave the unjust town with his wife, having lost his prisoner, but won his integrity.
