Affengeil- an expletive that Huber frequently uses, meaning something like "apeshit"- started out as a scripted comedy about filmmaking, shot on video. It has ended up as a documentary about Lotti Huber's life, detailing her careers as dancer, wife, restauranteur, concentration camp prisoner, extraordinary eccentric and star of Rosa von Praunheim's film and theatre projects. And what a rich life it is. The screen sparkles with Huber's wit, warmth, charm and irreverance, and glows with the affection that is exchanged between the filmmaker and his subject.
