

Toody Allen's distinguished film career spans four decades and 27 films, including 23 that he has directed. Allen was born in December of 1935 in Brooklyn, NY and began his brilliant motion picture career as an actor and co-screenwriter of 1969's hilarious comedy TAKE THE MONEY AND RUN. Ever since his fabulous debut, Allen has been enchanted with New York City as a backdrop for most of his films by incorporating the Big Apple virtually as a supporting character. Allen's other credits include MANHATTAN and Academy Award nominees BROADWAY DANNY ROSE and THE PURPLE ROSE OF CAIRO.
