Pedro Almodovar a few years back lensed an amateurish but spontaneous film called "Pepi, Luci and Bom," about a group of dissolute youngsters who spend their time immersed in small talk, sex and drugs. His latest effort is a far slicker and more professional product; the players this time are raving queens, punk singers, transvestites, and a freakish array of sexual aberrants who spend the film mouthing profanities, posing in costumes, indulging in most of the variants of sexual intercourse and pursuing a plot which is too silly even to come across as a spoof.

Yar volves take-offs on rincess Saya, the son of the Shah

lascivious gynecologist, and a bedazed girl working in a dry-cleaning store. Almodovar mixes them all together in an outlandish fashion, but before he's even half though the concoction goes sour.
