A couple of years ago, Marta Eggerth was the top femme draw on the continent; today she's just another German film star. Her voice is still as fine as ever, and she's still an eyeful, but stories and productions like the present one explain her decline. 'Hofkonzert' might have been a good musical in the ante-Hitler days, because then it would (probably) have had delicacy and a light touch. As is, it is handicapped mostly by heaviness and stodginess.

Miss Eggerth is spotted as singer whose mission in life is not so much to sing as to find out where and who her pappy is. She is invited to the royal court to sing, and there discovers that the king himself, a sweet and kindly soul, is father. Johannes Heesters, the Teutonic version of a handsome man, is the young officer in court who falls in love with her at first sight.

This is spun out in rather sheen fashion through 90 minutes, but with constant overhanging cloud of elephantiasi... That goes for production and acting. Miss Eggerth is the best actress in the cast, and she's a better singer. Music is very pleasan, but none too original, with no

song item of lasting memory.

Usa evidently thought this one might have a chance to get out of the regular limited channels for German films in the U.S. so decorated it with English titles (too many of them). Kauf. it won't help.
