For over a year, a serial killer haunted the Iranian town of Mashad, murdering 16 women – mostly prostitutes and drug addicts. Finally arrested, his trial became a sensation, with Islamic hardliners supporting the killer (who claimed that his crimes were in accordance with the Koran's instructions to ""prevent vice""), while reformers and liberals demanded his punishment. Frightening and compelling.

Palestinian filmmaker and actor Bakri visited the Jenin refugee camp after the massacre of April 2002, to record the testimonies of local residents - many of whom were still searching among the debris for the bodies of their loved ones.
