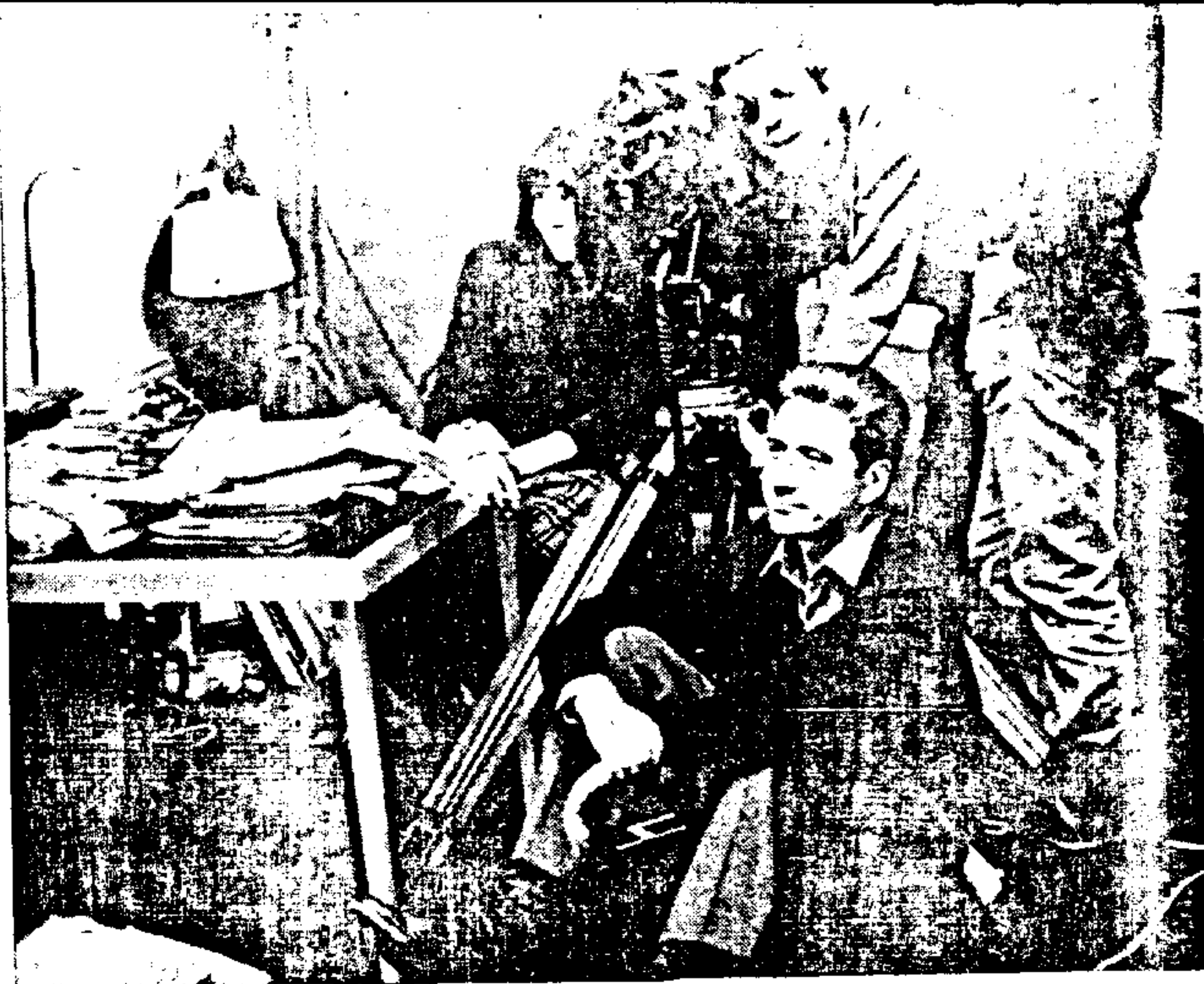

Six important film directors in Paris expressing their views on the Vietnam war. It is also extraordinary that a film by Alain Resnais, Jean-Luc Godard, Agnès Varda, Claude Lelouch, William Klein and Joris Ivens turns out to be a unified work. Much of the credit for this must go to Chris Marker, who put it all together. But there was also a kind of team spirit created by the situation in Vietnam itself which has acted as the true catalyst for this unusual group work, in which the artists speak directly and boldly to their audience.
