When Zanussi's *Constant* won the Jury Prize at Cannes in 1980, it was clear at last that Poland had produced a filmmaker to match Andrzej Wajda. Here was a director who could shape individual characters as skillfully as he could articulate ideas. While the concerns of most directors emerge from a cultural background, the landscape of Zanussi is mapped out in scientific terms: himself a lapsed physicist, he brings to the cinema a rare grasp of the problems faced by scientists in the modern world.

The Contract is his most recent film. The gathering of diverse people at a wedding party becomes a microcosm of Polish intellectual life. It's the conglomerate gathering of relatives, of exwives meeting the new spouses of ex-husbands; included is a kleptomaniac ex-ballerina, a guest on the verge of mental collapse and a mother-daughter hatred that flares into violence. The general undercurrent of pretension and nervous snobbery make The Contract a vast playground of psyches run-amok, where the spectator's attention is riveted to the actions of these human symbols of thwarted ideas.
