an all-around piece of musical splendour, in the MGM classical style, namely Fred Astaire. Although the title is linked to one of Astaire's great Broadway lits, this film bears no resemblance to the original (except for some of the Dietz-Schwartz Songs). Cyd Chariese is here for the languorous dance-movements, turning a gentle adagio in Central Park with astaire into à fineless pas de deux, and Vincente Minnellis direction is aimed artfully toward tigh entertainment. Jack Buchanan, astaire's British counterpart, is seen there in one of his final appearances, leaving one a fond glempse of his droll, dry sense of fun, and certainly, Michael Ridd's pop-ballet saturizing Mickey Spillane's detective novels is one of the most bulliant dance achievements in the history of the musical tilles tinema.

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
