"Nation" Film Back for Third Showing.

The return of "The Birth of a Nation" to the Grand opera house, Cincinnati, for a third engagement brought unusual interest recently, as the big drama made a record of nearly two months on its original engagement at the highest prices ever received in Cincinnati Mol a moving picture producti and then came back for a month the following season last year doing equally well. Its engagement on this occasion was for a week only, and at reduced prices, 25 and 50 cents; but the crowds which attended the two daily performances proved that the picture has lost nothing of its drawing power in spite of the fact that many thousands of people in Cincinnati have already seen it.
