

### Story:

While living with her aunt, in the Paris suburbs, Odile enrolls in an English-language school. There she meets Franz and tells him of her aunt's mysterious boarder, a M. Stolz, who allegedly hoards large sums of cash. Odile is persuaded by Franz and his friend, Arthur, to help them rob the house. Binding and gagging the aunt, they fail to find the money and discover that the old lady seems to have suffocated. Arthur eventually finds the money, but, along with his crooked uncle, who has joined the group, is killed in a shootout. M. Stolz returns and the aunt, having only fainted, is there to meet him. Franz and Oldile make a successful escape.
