costs: Unless officially invited to be shown in the Festival, all films and tapes are shipped to and from the Festival office at the entrant's expense. However, any unsolicited entry which is then selected for Festival presentation will be returned prepaid.

NOTE: All Golden Gate Awards and unsolicited entries shipped via airfreight from abroad must include \$35 Customs Broker fee per shipment.

HOW TO SHIP: Prints should be shipped on reels or cores, heads out and ends taped down. All containers must indicate film/tape title, shipper's name and address. Golden Gate Awards entrants must also indicate division and category. Each container must include a self-addressed return mailing label to facilitate return shipment.

The festival must be advised of all airfreight shipments. Please send a telex to the Festival office advising title, footage and piece amount, shipping method, arrival date, airline, flight number and airwaybill number.

INVITED ENTRANTS PLEASE NOTE: Prints arriving at Festival's expense must be shipped via Air Express International INTERPAK door-to-door service in time to arrive in San Francisco no later than February 15. To coordinate movement, telex AEI's SFO office (176217 AEISSF) with your company name, contact person, telephone number, and pieces and weight of shipment (maximum 32 kilos). AEI will contact you to arrange pick-up.

GOLDEN GATE AWARDS ENTRANTS PLEASE NOTE: All airfreight shipments from abroad must be accompanied by an additional \$35 Customs Broker fee per shipment to facilitate customs clearance. For your convenience (time permitting) we recommend Air Express International's INTERPAK door-todoor service. AEI will contact you to arrange pick-up.

RETURN All entries will be shipped to the return address supplied on your mailing label. Films/tapes not OF ENTRIES: selected for presentation in the Festival will be shipped back to you no later than March 1. Return will be via parcel post, special 4th class rate or via United Parcel Service. Overseas entries will be returned via surface mail (allow 6 weeks for delivery). If entrant specifies another means of return, film/tape will be sent collect. Entries screened in the Festival will be shipped within two weeks following the close of the Festival via AEI INTERPAK.

INSURANCE: Unless you indicate otherwise, tapes will be insured for \$100, 16mm prints for \$1,000, and 35mm prints for \$2,500. The Festival will insure against loss and damage of prints and tapes while in its possession, normal wear and tear excepted. Insurance and storage costs will be paid by the Festival from the time the entry is received until the time it is returned to the entrant.
