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



## EAUX D'ARTIFICE Summer Solstice 1953

### SCORPIO RISING Autumn Equinox 1964

'It may be conceded in any case that the long strings of formidable words which roar and moan through so many conjurations have a real effect in exalting the consciousness of the magician to the proper pitch — that they should do so is no more extraordinary than music of any kind should do so. 'Magicians have not confined themselves to the use of the human voice. The Pan-pipe with its seven stops, corresponding to the seven planets, the bull-roarer, the tom-tom, and even the violin, have all been used, as well as many others, of which the most important is the bell, though this is used not so much for actual conjuration as to mark stages in the ceremony. Of all these the tom-tom will be found to be the most generally useful.' — The Master Therion, Magick in Theory and Practice.

A conjuration of the Presiding Princes, Angels and Spirits of the Sphere of MARS, formed as a 'high' view of the Myth of the American Motorcyclist. The Power Machine seen as tribal totem, from toy to terror. Thanatos in chrome and black leather and bursting jeans. Part I: Boys & Bolts: (masculine fascination with the Thing that Goes). Part II: Image Maker (getting high on heroes: Dean's Rebel and Brando's Johnny; the True View of J.C.). Part III: Walpurgis Party (J.C. wallflower at the cycler's Sabbath). Part IV: Rebel Rouser (the Gathering of the Dark Legions, with a message from Our Sponsor).

# INAUGURATION OF THE PLEASURE DOME

Sacred Mushroom Edition Spring Equinox 1966 otherwise known as 'Lord Shiva's Dream.'

'A Eucharist of some sort should most assuredly be consummated daily by every magician, and he should regard it as the main sustenance of his magical life. It is of more importance than any other magical ceremony, because it is a complete circle. The whole of the force expended is completely re-absorbed; yet the virtue is that vast gain represented by the abyss between Man and God.

'The magician becomes filled with God, fed upon God, intoxicated with God. Little by little his body will become purified by the internal lustration of God; day by day his mortal frame, shedding its earthly elements, will become in very truth the Temple of the Holy Ghost. Day by day matter is replaced by Spirit, the human by the divine; ultimately the change will be complete; God manifest in flesh will be his name.'—The Master Therion (Aleister Crowley), Magick in Theory and Practice.

Lord Shiva, The Magician, wakes. A convocation of Theurgists in the guise of figures from mythology bearing gifts: The Scarlet Woman, Whore of Heaven, smokes a big fat joint; Astarte of the Moon brings the wings of snow; Pan bestows the bunch of Bacchus; Hecate offers the Sacred Mushroom, Yagé, Wormwood Brew. The vintage of Hecate is poured: Pan's cup is poisoned by Lord Shiva. The Orgia ensues; a Magick masquerade party at which Pan is the prize. Lady Kali blesses the rites of the Children of the Light as Lord Shiva invokes the Godhead with the formula, 'Force and Fire.' No film-maker in our times is misunderstood more than Kenneth Anger. In an age that has seen some of the most hated names in history, Anger has been publicly called 'the Most Monstrous Moviemaker in the Underground.'

The wildest rumors (some so fantastic they would be funny if they weren't vicious) have been started and kept circulating wherever he passed. Revered institutions dogged the steps of this self-styled disciple of 'Antichrist' and made sure that, wherever he found a friend, this friend should at once be told, by sources anxious for his soul's welfare, that Anger was a Satanist (whatever that may mean! . . .), a warlock, a sex-maniac, a murderer, a drug-addict, a madman.

This litany of his qualifications did not stop with his expatriation.

Legends have since sprung up about him. The mildest that can be said about most of them is that they are inaccurate. The rumors also keep going, now often about 'Anger's followers.' These are suspected by some very respectable entities, which ought to know better, to be a front for Fairy propaganda (!), In some 'occult' organizations it is believed that Anger and his fellow Thelemites slay and eat little children as a religious rite. Regular bogeymen, they!

But what is actually the philosophy and doctrines of this man, and what are the rites of these 'followers,' that so much care is taken to discredit? The world is full of warlocks and madmen; why single out this particular outcast and his dupes? Why slander Anger, why stone him, why smear him, why expose him on the age-old pillory of human fear, bigotry and stupidity? Why all the commotion? What does Anger have to show that is so terrible?

You will find in this Cycle the essence of all Kenneth Anger has reflected upon Magick, mysticism, psychology, philosophy, the world, God and man. (And woman!) Each film of this Cycle fills less than one hour; each film contains the quintessence of what learned scholars would write hundreds of volumes about. It is here; in four films and a fragment – Anger's whole vision – or his whole delusion!


No man is prophet in his own land and among his own people. 'Who is this,' they say, 'that he should preach to us? Did we not see him making chairs in Nazareth?' Also, the herd (generally instigated by their shepherds!) have always resented pioneers and innovators. Anger is called 'the Most Monstrous Moviemaker in the Underground' by Americans in his own America. He wanders over the whole globe and finds only misunderstanding everywhere.

Where shall this roving film-prophet find a rest? What land is there that did not see his birth? What religion is there that his 'Vision' does not attack? May Anger rest among the Christians, he who prides himself on adoring The Beast 666, the oldest terror of Christianity? Can he find it among the Buddhists, he who shouts that the essence of life is not sorrow, but joy? Might he find it among the Jews, he who calls Jehovah a petty and bloodthirsty father-demon? Among Mohammedans, he who believes himself a prophet of an ethos greater than Mohammed, the Aquarian Age?


It is perhaps necessary that Anger, sighting a phoenix-vision of a new mankind in a new world, should find no haven, no land for rest.

Do you, film-watcher, have moral courage? Do you have intellectual honesty? Are you not utterly bent spiritually under the Judeo-Christian American yoke, juicy prey, lamb of the fold of the slaves of the slave gods? In short, is there manhood in you yet?

Then watch these films, if you will, and meet the most monstrous moviemaker in the underground. Meet Kenneth Anger.



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
