Ten years ago, Marlon Riggs revolutionized the personal documentary genre with **Tongues Untied**. Its unique blend of poetry, personal stories, hip-hop and performance was a truly different aesthetic for its time, stretching the envelope of what people expected from a documentary. We could be grateful for that alone, but **Tongues** also accomplished an even more significant feat – shedding light on the "invisible" world/experiences of black gay men. Ten years later, the film retains its radically subversive potency and genius. This year we are screening **Tongues Untied** in honor of its ten-year anniversary.
