Here is the story of a street in post-World War I Vienna and its inhabitants, particularly a daughter (Greta Garbo), whose family finds that the father is out of his job during a time of severe inflation. The story was based on facts in Pabst's own life after the German defeat in Europe, and it encouraged other German film makers to use expressionism in dealing with such events. The film brought great fame to Pabst, while elevating Garbo to star status. * Although our prints fall short of perfect clarity, they are quite acceptablenot the commonly exhibited condensed prints which feature just the Garbo sequences.
