This 1964 Bunuel film is a pointed observation of the rise of fascism in 1939 France, a look at French social structure, and a comment on sexual mores as seen through the eyes of a lower-class chambermaid.

Jeanne Moreau stars as a servant who takes a position with a rather eccentric family in the country and quickly becomes acquainted with their life of bourgeoisie contentment. Bunuel's satiric wit and bite make this a darkly humorous but insightful film.
