The motion picture was shot entirely on location in and around an old manor house near Taxinge Nasby - about 70 miles north of Stockholm - on the shore of Lake Malar in the fall of 1971 and edited and scored in Stockholm and Faro in the spring of 1972.

THE NEW YORKER MAGAZINE, in its October 21st edition, published a 12,000 word story by Ingmar Bergman entitled "Cries and Whispers". This writing was, in fact, the working screenplay for the new motion picture and is a typical example of the director's method of notation in preparing his films for production.
