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PIROSMANI, 9:30
This film by Georgy Shenge aya was a surprise hit at the 1973 London Film Festival: its subject is the great Georgian primitive artist Niko Pirosmanishvili, whose work was done before 1920. The film avoids the usual cliches of films about artists' lives: using color control and a visual style base I on the painter's techniques. Avtandi Varazi plays the gentle, uncompromising artist who sold his paintings to bars and restaurants for food and drink, and worked mostly in solitude. (1971, 85 mins, color, 35mm)

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
