An impressive early work by a young woman director, Provincial Actors tells of a second-rate theatrical troupe, its difficulties in staging a classic play with a hotshot young director from Warsaw, and the disintegrating relationship between its leading actor and his wife, a failed actress who works in a puppet theatre. All of this is related in an agreeably open-ended behavioral, semi-verite style, geared toward flow rather than structure, and ideally suited to describe the bustling matrix of backstage life: gossip, backbiting, horseplay, grumbling, quarrels, exhibitionism, excitement, and frayed nerves. Director Agnieszka Holland deftly captures the haphazard and precarious lives of artists suspended in a volatile zone between greatness and mediocrity.
