Admirably offbeat and blackly comic crime caper come road movie. Jack is a good looking but unlucky car mechanic who is forced to be a courier of illegal 'medical supplies' in order to pay off his debts to two gangsters. However, if the trip were not risky enough, he is saddled with the baggage of a spoiled rich young woman who is desperate to escape the clutches of her domineering mother. Set in both Hamburg and Helsinki, this is a really good European genre movie with some delightfully wacky characters. In all, Highway Society is something of a triumph for Finnish director Mika Kaurismāki whose last film was LA Without a Map. Adrian Wootton.
