Sleazy, sexy, sophisticated and gay - but never insistently so - this is the tale of Pablo and Tino, two brothers who have lived apart since their parents separated when they were young. But Tino, now Tina (she changed her sex after moving in again with her father as his wife) now despises men while Pablo adores them. Indeed, his passionate predilections form the basis of the plot, which is part thriller, part black comedy but also a serious exploration of the price that's paid for love and lust - if you're not very careful. 'Almodóvar is the happiest, most entertaining hedonist in film today' (Enrique Fernandez, Village Voice) and this is a joyous fusion of his comic and cinematic talents variously at work in previous films like Matador and What Have I Done to Deserve This? Carmen Maura is incredible as Tina, playing the magnetic transsexual with accomplished glee. Almodóvar's dialogue is witty, the plot effortlessly intricate and the boys beautifully wicked. No wonder the film won a standing ovation at the Berlin Film Festival: it is one of the best Spanish films for many a year.-Peter Packer.
