Directed by the famous Cuban filmaker, Santiago Alverez, April in Vietnams is an outstanding documentary filmed in Vietnams. The film begins with a historic appreciation of Vietnamese culture and archaeology. The victories of the Vietnamese people are graphically depicted, tracing in comprehensive fashion the long history of Vietnam, from its origins to the total liberation of the country. The film takes the viewer south from Hanoi along Highway One following the liberation army and finally into Saigon an April 30, 1975.

April in Vietnam helps us all to learn about Vietnam, its people, land, culture, problems from severe war devastation and the excitment of post war reconstruction. It also documents what Vietnamese Prime Minister Pham Van Dong calls the "flowers of Cuban-Vietnamese friendship." It is a film that anyone interested in Vietnam of international solidarity should not miss.
