When the maniacally grinning visage of a strange cat began to pop up in odd places in Paris, on billboards (sporting wings), or dominating the square outside the Pompidou Centre, legendary director Chris Marker was sufficiently intrigued to pick up his camera and hunt this kitty down. The mad grin of insurrection, pussy power to the people, or "Make Cats, Not War!"--this elusive beast reared its bright yellow head as a symbol of protest at strikes, anti-war demonstrations, and many other political events in Paris.
