## SATAN TRIUMPHANT

- 2) The ascetic sermons of pastor Talnoks did not leave the faithful at peace with themselves
- 3) We do not need it. It suggests profane vanity
- 4) Are you not ashamed? You should try to fight the temptation
- 5) There were only two people who understood the pastor: Esfir his late wife's sister, and her husband, the painter Pavel
- 6) Stop it. This is not the right place for telling jokes!
- 7) Under the pastor's influence Esfir turned out to be more like a sister than a wife to Pavel
- 8) It was a gloomy, stormy night
- 9) Look! It seems that our God is going to visit our world lost in sin
- 10) I have lost my way and sprained my foot. May I come in?
- 11) We do not drink wine. It is a sin.
  Pardon? And has the pastor forgotten the wedding in Chana?
- 12) To the church? When the sun is shining so brightly? No thank you
- 13) Poor creature! All your saints will look like your wife
- 14) And you, so young and beautiful, what do you need the pastor's stupid sermons for?
- 15) Please, do not, I will get to the church on my own
- 16) You have a beautiful wife. Do not forget your conjugal rite
- 17) The stranger has recovered. The last day of his stay at the Pastor's has come
- 18) Should that beautiful woman, that neck, those eyes, really belong to the hunch-back?

- 30) What did you say? That this painting is 200 years old?
- 31) Talnoks did not buy the painting from the antique dealer, but he could not forget it
- 32) And for the first time in his life he wished he was not poor
- 33) I will go to the library
- 34) Can you imagine? They have stolen a painting from my shop. I should have offered it to Pastor Talnoks as a present yesterday...
- 35) The service should begin and the Pastor is not here...

The end of the film has not been preserved. Talnoks dies at the church where he comes to meet Esfir under the portrait of the Satan. At the same time amidst falling timber dies the hunch-back having found them together.
