While he is in his cabin, permanently sick, she is courted by a smooth Commander. Once the husband is well, he becomes infatuated by a 'princess' who proves to be an adventuress who rooks him of his money. The wife nearly leaves him for her Commander, but ultimately they survive a shipwreck and return home, sadder, wiser and still together.
