In his notice Mosk stated: "It stays true in spirit to Tolstoy in taking a basically simple tale and imbuing it with fervor, insight, compassion and achieving an almost cosmic statement on the place of love within the context of a certain society at a certain time. No forced revolutionary statements but the inexorable need for man to evolve.
