Condemned as a failure on its release by most critic: and immediately cut, A Canterbury Tale has now bee fully restored. Essentially it is an extended meditation on the positive and negative aspects of tradition - a call to adjust to the reality of wartime Britain while respecting the past - hung on the slender ta'e of a U.S. sergeant spending several days' leave on his way to see Canterbury Cathedral.
