Amazing thing about this is that the authorism: Thea you Harbou, wrote this munueferifit before Peter Kuerten was ever arrested, which proves that her vision forenaw the problem of this human beant.

The town is looking for a murderer who is terrorizing the whole city. Children disappear and are found dead. Police force la mobilfred and also the underworld, as due to the constant raids of the police their business is endangered.

After a thrilling chase the murderer is caught by the gangater organizations. The work of the police. of the criminal department, the ralds and police patrois, the spy work of the gangaters, all this is aplendully worked out and realistically.

Here Lang shows his great ability. When the captured murderer is Brought before the court of the underworld beganization and senthinged, the audience in part profeets and in part agrees with the mentence-it is eo true.

The performance takes two hours. a little too long Without apolling the effect -- even bettering it -- rut-

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ting could be done. There are a few repetitions and a few draggy acenes.

Peter Lorre does unusually well as the murderer, changing from human despair to bestial lust. It is most gripping when he pleads for human treatment and understanding for his pathological tendencies.

Technical art soars to unknown human heights, and a tremendous group of splendid actors, too big to separately comment. Otto Wernicke. as the chief of the criminal department, achieves such perfect work one is reminded of Lon Chaney's fluires. Theodor Loos and Gerhard Bienert are also splendid as criminal policemen. In between are two fine actresses: Rosa Valetti and Margurete Melzer.

A very great artistic success for Fritz Lang and Thea von Harbou, and a great box office picture for the producer, Seymour Nebenzahl. who, with his Neroslim productions this season has shown more courauc and energy to create something new than any other German film company, including Ula. Magnus
