Brady Turns Back Pages

Going into "Destination Inner Space" in which he toplines the cast was a bit like turn-paging for Scott Brady. In the science fiction-sea mystery, now at thetheatre, he portrays a United States Navy commander.

Brady's entrance into acting, first on the stage and later in motion pictures, came about after he had served a hitch in Uncle Sam's Navy during World War II.

The ruggedly handsome star, born Jerry Tierney in New York, did a number of jobs before settling on acting as a career. Among them were lumber-jacking in the Maine woods and working as a life guard on Southern California beaches. His first film was "Underwater Girl."

Starred with him in his current film are Gary Merrill, Sheree North, Wende Wagner and Mike Road. Released by Magna Pictures Distribution Corporation, the color film was produced by Earle Lyon for United Pictures Corporation which presents it in association with Harold Goldman Associates, Inc.



SYNOPSIS

(Not For Publication)

Navy Commander Wayne (Scott Brady) boards a civilian sea laboratory to aid scientists in identifying a moving object first detected by instrument. He meets Dr. Le Satier (Gary Merrill), chief scientist, Sandra (Sheree North), photographer, and Hugh (Mike Road), former Navy man. Mutual dislike between commander and ex-sailor is explained when Wayne charges the latter with cowardice resulting in the deaths of several sailors. Hugh admits to the accusation, but all work together to solve the mystery. The object eventually is seen to be a large powered craft, oval in shape. When it passes close to the laboratory, the latter's radio is damaged beyond repair. Later, a man-like monster emerges from the oval, wrecks the barge with which the laboratory is connected, leaving the scientists with only a 12hour air supply; then it gains entry to the laboratory, kills a crewman, injures others, then returns to the oval. Wayne devises a way to trap the monster, but it is Hugh who sacrifices his own life in destroying the monster and saving the lives of the others, including Sandra with whom he had fallen in love.


SYNOPSIS


