James Whale is a cult director, whose work has received little scholarly attention, one reason possibly being that no special collections devoted to Whale are known to exist in libraries or film institutions. The Academy's Margaret Herrick Library holds a small biographical file on James Whale, together with files of clippings and/or stills on the following films directed by him.
